1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Tipton Airport Authority – Terms of Members

3 FOR the purpose of modifying the terms of the members of the Tipton Airport Authority
4 to include a general termination date; providing that new terms shall run with the
5 terms of the County Executive; and generally relating to the Tipton Airport Authority.

7 BY repealing and reenacting, with amendments: § 3-12-204(c)
8 Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended)

10 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County,*
11 *Maryland,* That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as
12 follows:

14 ARTICLE 3. BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND SIMILAR BODIES

15 TITLE 12. TIPTON AIRPORT AUTHORITY

16 17 18 **3-12-204. Membership.** 19

20 (c) **Term of office.** The term of a member is five years. The terms of members are
21 staggered so that of the initial members, the term of at least one member, but not more
22 than two members, ends on December 31 of each of the five years following
23 establishment of the Authority. EXCEPT AS PROVIDED HEREIN, ON DECEMBER 3, 2018,
24 TERMS OF ALL MEMBERS THEN SERVING SHALL TERMINATE. THEREAFTER, MEMBERS
25 SHALL BE APPOINTED TO TERMS COTERMINOUS WITH THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE. At the
26 end of a term, a member continues to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies. A

EXPLANATION: CAPITALS indicate new matter added to existing law.
[Brackets] indicate matter stricken from existing law.

1 member who is appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and
2 until a successor is appointed and qualifies. A member may be reappointed.

4 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days
5 from the date it becomes law.
