13	SECTION 1. Be it enacted, That Sections(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005,
14	as amended) read as follows:

20	18-2-202. Zoning certificate of use.

22 23 24 25 26	(E) Publication. THE OFFICE OF PLANNING AND ZONING SHALL POST ON THE COUNTY'S WEBSITE A LIST OF ALL CURRENT ZONING CERTIFICATES OF USE AND ANY PENDING APPLICATIONS FOR A ZONING CERTIFICATE OF USE. THE LIST SHALL INCLUDE THE DATE OF APPLICATION, THE DATE OF APPROVAL, AND THE DATE OF EXPIRATION OF THE CERTIFICATE.

18-2-203. Temporary uses.

Except where specific temporary uses are provided for in this Code, and upon a determination that a temporary use of land will not adversely affect nearby properties and will not require significant or permanent changes to existing topography, vegetation, or other natural features, the Planning and Zoning Officer may authorize the use in any zoning district for a period not exceeding 60 days. The Planning and Zoning Officer may grant up to two extensions of the temporary use for periods not exceeding 60 days each. The land shall be entirely cleared of the temporary use within five days after the expiration of the period. APPROVAL OF A TEMPORARY USE SHALL BE INCLUDED IN THE POSTED LIST OF APPROVED CERTIFICATES OF USE REQUIRED PURSUANT TO § 18-2-202(E) AND SHALL INCLUDE THE DATE OF APPROVAL, DATE OF EXPIRATION, AND DATES OF EXTENSION, IF ANY, OF THE TEMPORARY USE.

SECTION 2. And be it further enacted, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
