1	RESOLUTION recognizing Childhood Cancer Awareness Month in Anne Arundel
2	County
3 4 5	WHEREAS, each year more than 15,000 children under the age of 19 in the United States, and more than 300,000 children globally, are diagnosed with cancer,
6	according to the National Cancer Institute; and
7 8	WHEREAS, the American Cancer Fund for Children and Kids Cancer Connection
8 9	report that cancer is the leading cause of death by disease among U.S. children
10	between infancy and age 15; and
11	setween maney and age 15, and
12	WHEREAS, cancer occurs regularly and randomly and spares no racial or ethnic
13	group, socioeconomic class, or geographic region; and
14	
15	WHEREAS, one in five children diagnosed with cancer in the U.S. will not survive,
16	and for those who do, the battle is never over; and
17	
18	WHEREAS, one in four families lose more than 40% of their annual household
19 20	income as a result of childhood cancer treatment-related work disruption, while one in three families face other work disruptions such as having to quit or change jobs <sup>1</sup> ;

23	WHEREAS, attention to the importance of continued medical research to find
24	better and safer treatments and cures for childhood cancer and proper support are
25 26	crucial for kids fighting cancer and their families and caregivers; and
20 27	WHEREAS, Childhood Cancer Awareness Month is an annual national health
28	campaign organized by major childhood cancer organizations to increase
20 29	awareness of pediatric cancer and to bring attention to the importance of research
30	into its cause, prevention, diagnosis, treatment, and cure; now, therefore, be it
31	
32	Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it hereby
33	honors children with cancer, childhood cancer survivors, children who have passed away
34	from cancer, and all of the families, healthcare providers, researchers, caregivers, and
35	community organizations dedicated to improving the lives of children and young adults
36	with cancer; and be it further
