1 RESOLUTION confirming the appointments of members of the classified service to
2 serve on the Pension Oversight Commission for Anne Arundel County

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4 WHEREAS, the Charter of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, Section 606(a)
5 provides that there shall be a Pension Oversight Commission that is independent
6 of both the legislative and executive branches of the County government; and

7
8 WHEREAS, the Charter, Section 606(b)(1) provides that the Pension Oversight
9 Commission shall consist of nine members appointed by the County Executive
10 and confirmed by resolution of the County Council; and

11
12 WHEREAS, the Charter, Section 606(b)(3) provides that four of the members
13 shall be members of the classified service as defined in Section 803 of the County
14 Charter; and one shall be a uniformed police officer; one shall be a professional
15 firefighter; one shall be a member of a class represented by the employee
16 organization that represents the majority of classified employees other than
17 uniformed police officers and professional fire fighters; and one shall be a
18 member of the classified service other than the police department and fire
19 department, who is in a class excluded from representation by the employee
20 organization that represents the majority of classified employees other than
21 uniformed police officers and professional fire fighters; and

23 WHEREAS, the Charter, Section 606(c)(1) provides that the term of a member
24 shall be four years; and

25
26 WHEREAS, the Charter, Section 606(c)(3) provides that a member who is
27 appointed after a term has begun shall serve only for the rest of the term and until
28 a successor is appointed and qualified; and

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30 WHEREAS, the Charter, Section 606(c)(4) provides that a person may not serve
31 for more than two terms as a member of the Pension Oversight Commission; and

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33 WHEREAS, the County Executive, subject to confirmation by the County
34 Council, has appointed from a list of names nominated by secret ballot by
35 members of the classified service classified service members William C. DeHoff,
36 Jr. (a member of the classified service other than the police department and fire
37 department, who is in a class excluded from representation by the employee

1 organization that represents the majority of classified employees other than
2 uniformed police officers and professional fire fighters), Michael Shier
3 (uniformed police officer), and Robert Stull (a member of a class represented by
4 the employee organization that represents the majority of classified employees
5 other than uniformed police officers and professional fire fighters) to first terms
6 expiring on January 31, 2020; and

8 WHEREAS, the County Council, after public hearing, finds that William C.
9 DeHoff, Jr., Michael Shier, and Robert Stull meet the eligibility requirements
10 under the Anne Arundel County Charter, Section 606(b)(3), and are qualified to
11 serve on the Pension Oversight Commission; now, therefore, be it
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13 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it hereby
14 approves the appointment to the Pension Oversight Commission of classified service
15 members William C. DeHoff, Jr., Michael Shier, and Robert Stull to first terms expiring
16 January 31, 2020; and be it further

18 *Resolved,* That a copy of this Resolution be sent to Steven R. Schuh, County
19 Executive; O'Brien Atkinson, Chairman of the Pension Oversight Commission; and
20 appointees William C. DeHoff, Jr., Michael Shier, and Robert Stull.


