Charter Amendment – Legislative Procedure – Emergency Ordinances

RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the Charter of Anne Arundel County to allow the use of an emergency ordinance to address a situation that needs immediate action 2 3 4

Be it resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the following amendment to the Anne Arundel County Charter is proposed for submission to the qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2020:

Article III. The Legislative Branch

10 Section 307. Legislative procedure.

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(i) Effective Date of Ordinances; Prohibited Subject Matter for Emergency 12 Ordinances. Except as provided in Section 710 of this Charter for the Annual Budget and 13 14 Appropriation Ordinance and ordinances levying taxes or assessments to support the budget, and except for any ordinance related to transfers of appropriations under Charter 15 Section 711, supplementary appropriations under Charter Section 712, and amendments of 16 the capital budget under Charter Section 716, AND EXCEPT FOR EMERGENCY ORDINANCES, 17 18 any ordinance enacted by the County Council shall take effect forty-five days after it becomes law, unless declared to be effective on a later date. Ordinances related to transfers 19 20 of appropriations under Charter Section 711, supplementary appropriations under Charter Section 712, and amendments of the capital budget under Charter Section 716 shall take 21 effect from the date they become law. If an ordinance is an emergency ordinance as defined 22 23 in Section 208(d), or if an ordinance passed at an annual legislative session or a monthly 24 legislative session-day be declared by the County Council to be an emergency ordinance necessary for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health, safety, and welfare 25 OR TO ADDRESS A SITUATION THAT NEEDS IMMEDIATE ACTION, it shall take effect from 26 the date it becomes law. An emergency ordinance [[shall]] MAY not levy taxes, create 27 revenue, [[or]] grant a franchise or special privilege, [[or]] abolish or create any office, 28 [[or]] change any salary, term, or duty of any officer, [[or]] create any vested right or 29 interest, or create or expand any Capital Project[[,]] or increase the funding [[thereof 30 (except in cases where]] FOR A CAPITAL PROJECT UNLESS the increase in funding is 31

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required solely to meet cost escalation and does not affect the scope of the project as

And be it further resolved, That the following question is adopted for submittal to the qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2020 for their adoption or rejection:

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8 "To amend the Anne Arundel County Charter to allow the use of an emergency
9 ordinance to address a situation that needs immediate action."

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And be it further resolved, That this question shall be designated as Question "___"
 on the ballot at the General Election in November 2020.

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And be it further resolved, That if the majority of qualified votes cast in the election are for the Charter Amendment, this amendment shall stand adopted from and after the 30th

16 day following the election.
