1	RESOLUTION urging the County Executive to respond to a request for documentation
2	from the County Auditor

4	WHEREAS, Section 311 of the County Charter provides for open inspection to the
5	County Auditor of all records and files pertaining to the receipt and expenditure of
6	County funds by all agents and employees of the County and all County offices,
7	departments, institutions, boards, commissions, courts, corporations and other
8	agencies; and
9	
10	WHEREAS, Section 311 further provides that the County Council shall have the
11	power to assign additional functions, duties and personnel to the County Auditor
12	not inconsistent with those duties provided in Section 311; and
13	
14	WHEREAS, Resolution No. 48-15 recognized and memorialized additional duties
15	of the County Auditor to include a duty to submit to the County Council a written
16	assessment of the fiscal and public policy considerations of each bill and resolution
17	in advance of the scheduled legislative hearing date; and
18	
19	WHEREAS, since February 19, 2019 the County Auditor has made repeated
20	requests regarding information related to Department of Public Works' current cost
21	estimates to complete certain sub-projects in the capital budget, detailed by expense
22	categories, along with the most recent engineer construction cost estimates; and
23	
24	WHEREAS, the information requested will not be released to the County Auditor
25	by the Department of Public Works until the Office of the Budget approves even
26	though open inspection of all records and files pertaining to the receipt and
27	expenditure of County funds is guaranteed under the Charter and it will become a
28	part of a duty to assess the fiscal and public policy of the proposed County budget
29	for fiscal year 2020; and

31	WHEREAS, there is no lawful basis for withholding the information requested by
32	the County Auditor and failing to provide it in a timely manner is preventing the
33	County Auditor from performing the duties of that office; now, therefore, be it
