5	WHEREAS, in 2016, the United States Environmental Protection Agency (the
6 7 8	"EPA") designated portions of Baltimore and northern Anne Arundel County as an area of nonattainment for the 2010 1-hour sulfur dioxide ("SO ₂ ") primary national ambient air quality standard; and

10	WHEREAS, the SO ₂ nonattainment designation was based on air quality data
11 12	obtained during a three-year period, from 2013 to 2015, showing elevated levels of SO ₂ in the areas surrounding the H. A. Wagner and Brandon Shores Power
13	Plants; and

15	WHEREAS, the potential for negative health effects from poor air quality caused
16	by the coal-burning power plants is of great concern to the citizens of the County
17	and the County Council; and

19	WHEREAS, the Maryland Department of the Environment has indicated to
20	County residents that monitoring of the air quality in Northern Anne Arundel
21 22	County is a high priority due to the potential negative health effects; and
23	WHEREAS, the Wagner power plant is now using a lower-sulphur bituminous
24	coal that could result in better air quality results for the plant; and
25	our that could be deter air quality results for the plant, and
26	WHEREAS, monitoring equipment installed in close proximity to the H. A.
27	Wagner and Brandon Shores power plants will provide assurances that air quality
28	is improving; and

30	WHEREAS, the EPA has provided millions of dollars to researchers to conduct
31	air quality studies in Baltimore, some of which should be used to measure air
32	quality in Northern Anne Arundel County, as it was also included in the
33	nonattainment designation; and
