1 RESOLUTION concerning a determination by the County Council to engage the
2 services of an outside attorney to assist the County Council in certain matters relating to
3 legislation regarding the licensing of certain towing companies performing towing at the
4 request of the Police Department

6 WHEREAS, Section 314 of the Anne Arundel County Charter empowers the
7 County Council, by resolution, to engage the services of experts, consultants or
8 attorneys to aid in its inquiries, investigations or the drafting and codification of
9 legislation; and

11 WHEREAS, the introduction of County Council Bill No. 34-17 has raised
12 concerns regarding the extent to which the bill can provide for regulation of the
13 licensing and administration of the Police-Initiated towing program; and

15 WHEREAS, the County Council has determined that, because of the complex
16 nature and effect of the foregoing bill, and concerns asserted by the County
17 Administration, it would be beneficial to have the advice of outside counsel; now,
18 therefore, be it

20 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That, subject to*
21 *budget and appropriation provisions, it hereby determines to engage the service of*
22 *outside counsel to assist the Council in reviewing the legislation and communications*
23 *from the Anne Arundel County Office of Law.*


