1 RESOLUTION urging members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education and
2 the Superintendent of Anne Arundel County Public Schools to promote and increase STEM
3 and cyber educational opportunities in all County schools

5 WHEREAS, Anne Arundel County is home to cyber security resources such as Fort
6 George G. Meade, the United States Cyber Command, and the National Security
7 Agency; and

9 WHEREAS, Anne Arundel County Public Schools is uniquely positioned to
10 expose, educate, and prepare students in the County for careers in
11 cybersecurity through its STEM and technology based programs; and

13 WHEREAS, the County Council, as the legislative body for Anne Arundel County,
14 is supportive of new and innovative programs in public education to prepare County
15 students for the future; and

17 WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes the importance of STEM and cyber
18 based education programs in our County; and

20 WHEREAS, the County would benefit from the creation and enhancement of
21 STEM and cyber educational opportunities and curricula for teachers and students;
22 now, therefore, be it

24 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,* That it hereby
25 urges members of the Anne Arundel County Board of Education and the Superintendent
26 of Anne Arundel County Public Schools to promote and increase STEM and cyber
27 educational opportunities for all teachers and students in County schools and to inspire
28 students to pursue cybersecurity careers; and be it further
