1 2	RESOLUTION urging the Federal Aviation Administration to modify flight paths and elevations imposed by NextGen Air Transportation System to pre-NextGen paths and
3	to place warnings in the Automated Terminal Information System to ensure pilots comply
4	with required altitude during their approach to Baltimore-Washington Marshall
5	International Airport and move forward with the requests and recommendations of the
6	DC Metroplex BWI Community Roundtable
7	
8	WHEREAS, the Federal Aviation Administration has imposed new flight patterns
9	as a part of their NextGen Air Transportation System; and
10	
11	WHEREAS, the resulting changes in flight paths and elevations altitudes has a
12	negative impact on the quality of life for a large number of Anne Arundel County
13	residents, some many miles away from Baltimore-Washington Marshall
14	International Airport ("BWI"), far outside the Airport Noise Zone designated by
15	the State of Maryland; and
16	
17	WHEREAS, Maryland Governor Larry Hogan as well as members of the
18	Maryland Congressional Delegation have expressed opposition to the new and
19	concentrated flight paths and altitudes resulting from NextGen flight patterns and
20	have demanded that the FAA revert to the former flight paths for BWI; and
21	
22	WHEREAS, the County Council has received numerous calls and emails from
23	citizens directly affected by the change in flight paths patterns, with Anne
24	Arundel County neighborhoods increasingly affected by noise and, light, and air
25	pollution nuisance from low-flying aircraft for almost 24 hours a day; and
26	
27	WHEREAS, any savings realized through the NextGen system should be
28	balanced against the growing impact on local communities; and
29	
30	WHEREAS, the County Council requests the Maryland Department of
31	Transportation Aviation Administration conduct a reexamination of the noise
32	standards established in the Maryland Environmental Noise Act of 1974 and
33	update them to a modern system that more accurately reflects the impact aviation
34	noise has on Anne Arundel County residents; and

WHEREAS, the County Council further requests the Maryland Department of

Transportation Aviation Administration reexamine the Noise Abatement

procedures around BWI to better mitigate the noise impact current aircraft 1 operations are having on County residents; and 2 3 WHEREAS, the County Council supports the DC Metroplex BWI Community 4 5 Roundtable's continuing communication to the FAA citing concerns and effects of the NextGen system that must be addressed and alleviated by the FAA PBN 6 Working Group or whatever other FAA process may be necessary; and 7 8 9 WHEREAS, the County Council urges the Federal Aviation Administration to revisit the NextGen flight pattern plan and, wherever possible, revert to the former 10 flight paths as soon as practicable; and 11 12 13 WHEREAS, the County Council further urges the Federal Aviation Administration to take immediate steps to ensure pilots maintain appropriate 14 altitude in the flight path through warnings in the Automated Terminal 15 16 Information system; therefore, be it 17 18 WHEREAS the County Council fully supports the requests and recommendations of the DC Metroplex BWI Community Roundtable as described in their March 19 31, 2017 and July 25, 2017 letters to the FAA, to resolve the harmful effects of 20 the NextGen flight paths and procedures on BWI communities and residents; 21 22 therefore, be it 23 24 Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, that the Anne Arundel County Council urges the Federal Aviation Administration to return the flight 25 patterns at Baltimore-Washington Marshall International Airport to pre-NextGen paths 26 27 and to immediately place warnings in the Automated Terminal Information System to ensure pilots comply with required altitude during their approach to BWI and move 28 forward with the requests and recommendations of the DC Metroplex BWI Community 29 30 Roundtable; and be it further 31 32 Resolved, That a copy of this Resolution be sent to Michael P. Huerta, Administrator, Federal Aviation Administration. 33
