RESOLUTION approving the declaration of certain non-buildable County-owned property near Hollyberry Road in Severna Park, Maryland as surplus property

WHEREAS, § 8-3-208 of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) (and as amended by Bill No. 79-16) authorizes the County to dispose of County-owned property by private disposition if the property is declared by the Planning and Zoning Officer to be non-buildable, is less than one-tenth of an acre in size, and is determined by the Central Services Officer to be surplus property, and if said determination is approved by the Chief Administrative Officer and by resolution of the County Council; and

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Officer has declared that certain County-owned property located near Hollyberry Road in Severna Park, Maryland, as described herein (the "Property"), is non-buildable, the Central Services Officer has determined that the Property is surplus, and the Chief Administrative Officer has approved the Central Services Officer's determination; and

WHEREAS, after a public hearing on this Resolution, the County Council approves the Central Services Officer's determination that the Property is surplus; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That in accordance with § 8-3-208 of the County Code, it hereby approves the determination that the property near Hollyberry Road, Severna Park, Maryland, located in the Fifth Councilmanic District, containing 0.021 acres of land, more or less, is surplus property, being more fully described as:

Beginning for the same at a point which is the northeasternmost corner of Lot "N" as shown on the plat of West Severna Park, Section D, dated September, 1957 and recorded among the Land Records of Anne Arundel County, Maryland in Plat Book 30, folio 29, said point also being the end of the division line between Lots No. 4 and 5, thence from the point of beginning so fixed and referring the following courses to the Maryland State Grid Meridian.

- 1. South 11 degrees 11 minutes 40 seconds East 70.00 feet
- 2. South 78 degrees 48 minutes 20 seconds West 5.00 feet
- 3. North 11 degrees 11 minutes 40 seconds West 20.00 feet
- 4. North 56 degrees 11 minutes 40 seconds West 25.00 feet
