FISCAL NOTE

BILL: AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING: PUBLIC WORKS—PERMITS FOR USE OF COUNTY RIGHTS-OF-WAY—MAINTENANCE PERMIT AND INSPECTION FEES


SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

The purpose of this legislation is to require that a utility be invoiced quarterly for right-of-way maintenance permit and inspection fees, and require that a utility be assessed a penalty on maintenance permit and inspection fees unpaid after 30 days.

FISCAL IMPACT

This legislation is intended to facilitate timely collection of right-of-way permit fees. If payments are submitted late, the penalty charge in this legislation will increase revenue.

This legislation does not significantly change the administration of utility billing. Any additional effort will be minimal and can be absorbed with existing staff. No additional expenses are anticipated for implementation of this legislation.
