
**BILL: AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING: BOARDS, COMMISSIONS, AND SIMILAR BODIES – RESILIENCE AUTHORITY OF ANNAPOLIS AND ANNE ARUNDEL COUNTY**

**SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION**

The purpose of this legislation is to add a certain non-voting advisor; stagger the initial terms of members; provided that the Director shall be a County employee in the exempt service; revise the process for appointing and qualifications of a Chief Financial Officer; alter certain reporting requirements; and generally relating to boards, commissions, and similar bodies.

**FISCAL IMPACT**

The Resilience Authority is a quasi-governmental county agency. The legislation stipulates that the executive director of the Resilience Authority shall be a county employee, but as this is already the current practice, there is no new anticipated fiscal impact.
