RESOLUTION: AUTHORIZING THE FILING OF AN APPLICATION WITH THE MARYLAND TRANSIT ADMINISTRATION OF THE MARYLAND DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR AN ANNUAL TRANSPORTATION PLAN GRANT AND OTHER FUNDS UNDER THE FEDERAL TRANSIT ACT FOR FEDERAL FISCAL YEAR 2023

SUMMARY OF LEGISLATION

This Resolution approves the County’s application for grants/financial assistance from the Maryland Transit Administration (MTA) under provisions of the Federal Transit Act for federal fiscal year 2023. The MTA is designated the direct recipient of these funds and is authorized to make transportation related grants to counties and other local jurisdictions.

FISCAL IMPACT


