1	RESOLUTION supporting the goals and recommendations of the Joint Initiative to

4	WHEREAS, the County Council recognizes that an opportunity gap related to race
5 6	and income exists for some children in the Anne Arundel County Public School system; and

8	WHEREAS, poverty, income inequality, unsafe housing, poor nutrition, and
9 10	inadequate health care are contributing factors and, for Black students, structural and systemic racism perpetuate these inequities; and

12	WHEREAS, school readiness and achievement continues to widen as these

15	WHEREAS, in 2019, County Executive Steuart Pittman and Superintendent
16 17	George Arlotto created the Joint Initiative to Eliminate the Achievement Gap, to address persistent disparities in academic performance among different groups of
18	students, and the name was later changed to the Joint Initiative to Eliminate the
19	Opportunity Gap to recognize the gap in metrics is not related to innate ability; and
20	
21	WHEREAS, a committee to oversee the initiative was assigned and representatives
22	from various agencies and organizations were invited to be a members of the Joint
23	Initiative to Eliminate the Opportunity Gap committee; and

25	WHEREAS, on September 23, 2019, more than 200 participants attended a
26	community launch meeting and the data collected during the meeting resulted in
27	the creation of five subcommittees to address social determinants of education,
28 29	systemic racism, discipline, family life, and curriculum; and
30	WHEREAS, in its November 30, 2020 report, the Joint Initiative to Eliminate the
31	Opportunity Gap committee recognized that the County's most vulnerable students
32	are caught in the gap even before they enter school, and recommended strategies to
33	increase opportunities and remove barriers to success for these students; now,
34	therefore, be it
