Charter Amendment – County Council – Terms of Office

3 RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the Charter of Anne Arundel County to  
4 allow a Councilmember to serve up to three consecutive terms of office  
5

6 *Be it resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the*  
7 *following amendment to the Anne Arundel County Charter is proposed for submission to*  
8 *the qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2022:*

10 **Article II. The County Council**

11  
12 **Sec. 203. Term of office.**

13  
14 Each member of the County Council shall hold office for a term of four years  
15 commencing on the first Monday in December following election, or as soon thereafter as  
16 practicable, and shall enter upon the duties of the office immediately upon qualification  
17 and serve until a successor shall qualify. [[No person elected or appointed to the office of  
18 County Councilmember shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself in the office if he or  
19 she has served in the office for two full consecutive four-year terms at or after January 1,  
20 1994.]] NO COUNCIL MEMBER MAY SERVE MORE THAN THREE CONSECUTIVE TERMS.

22 *And be it further resolved, That the following question is adopted for submittal to the*  
23 *qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2022 for their adoption*  
24 *or rejection:*

26 “To amend the Anne Arundel County Charter to provide that no person elected or  
27 appointed to the office of County Councilmember may serve more than three full  
28 consecutive four-year terms.”  
29

30 *And be it further resolved, That this question shall be designated as Question “\_\_” on*  
31 *the ballot at the General Election in November 2022.*

33 *And be it further resolved, That if the majority of qualified votes cast in the election*  
34 *are for the Charter Amendment, this amendment shall stand adopted from and after the 30<sup>th</sup>*  
35 *day following the election.*
