3 RESOLUTION proposing an amendment to the Charter of Anne Arundel County to
4 require that the compensation paid to each member of the County Council be ~~in accordance~~
5 with after consideration of recommendations of the Salary Standard Commission that are
6 approved by ordinance of the County Council

8 *Be it resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the*
9 *following amendment to the Anne Arundel County Charter is proposed for submission to*
10 *the qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2022:*

12 **Article II. The County Council**

14 **Sec. 204. Compensation.**

15
16 Each member of the County Council shall be paid ~~[[for the performance of his duties~~
17 ~~as provided in this Charter the sum of Twenty-one Hundred Dollars (\$2,100.00) per annum.~~
18 ~~Such salary shall be]]~~ AFTER CONSIDERATION OF THE
19 RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE SALARY STANDARD COMMISSION ADOPTED BY ORDINANCE
20 OF THE COUNTY COUNCIL in full compensation for all services required by law or by this
21 Charter to be performed by the members of the County Council. No member of the County
22 Council shall be entitled to any other allowance of any kind, except ~~[[that]],~~ subject to
23 approval of the Council, ~~[[he may be allowed his]]~~ actual necessary expenses incurred in
24 representing the County beyond the geographical boundaries thereof.

26 *And be it further resolved, That the following question is adopted for submittal to the*
27 *qualified voters of the County at the General Election in November 2022 for their adoption*
28 *or rejection:*

30 “To amend the Anne Arundel County Charter to require that the compensation paid to
31 each member of the County Council be paid ~~in accordance with~~ after consideration of
32 recommendations of the Salary Standard Commission that are approved by ordinance of
33 the County Council.”

1 *And be it further resolved,* That this question shall be designated as Question “__” on
2 the ballot at the General Election in November 2022.

4 *And be it further resolved,* That if the majority of qualified votes cast in the election
5 are for the Charter Amendment, this amendment shall stand adopted from and after the 30th
6 day following the election.
