1 RESOLUTION expressing the County Council's sympathies and condolences to the
2 family of Candace C.W. Antwine and to her colleagues on the Board of Education

4 WHEREAS, on July 16, 2021, Anne Arundel County lost one of its champions for
5 public education with the sudden passing of Candace C.W. Antwine; and

7 WHEREAS, Ms. Antwine was the first person elected to represent District One on
8 the Board of Education for Anne Arundel County, serving a six-year term that
9 began on December 3, 2018; and

11 WHEREAS, Ms. Antwine was a committed advocate for all students in Anne
12 Arundel County with a deep passion for equity in education and accessible, quality
13 education that meets the needs of every student; and

15 WHEREAS, Ms. Antwine demonstrated her commitment through her hard work on
16 the Board's policy and equity committees as well as her collaborative work with
17 several committees of the Maryland Association of Boards of Education; and

19 WHEREAS, Ms. Antwine was also a U.S. Navy veteran who advocated for military
20 families throughout Anne Arundel County; and

22 WHEREAS, Ms. Antwine was a devoted mother and member of the community
23 whose life of service is a testament for others who strive for the best in personal
24 and community life; now, therefore, be it

26 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it hereby*
27 *expresses its sincere sympathy and heartfelt condolences on the passing of Candace C.W.*
28 *Antwine, whose death is a profound loss to her son, her family and friends, her colleagues,*
29 *and all of Anne Arundel County; and be it further*

31 *Resolved, That a copy of this resolution to be sent to the family of Candace C.W.*
32 *Antwine as an expression of the gratitude felt by the County Council for her contributions*
33 *to Anne Arundel County, in particular District One, and of the high esteem and affection*
