1 RESOLUTION appointing a member to the Anne Arundel County Adult Public
2 Guardianship Review Board

4 WHEREAS, § 14-402(a)(1) of the Family Law Article of the State Code requires
5 that the Anne Arundel County Adult Public Guardianship Review Board consist of
6 11 members appointed by the County Executive with the advice and consent of the
7 County Council; and

8
9 WHEREAS, § 14-402(a)(2) of the Family Law Article of the State Code requires
10 that, of the 11 members, one shall be a professional representative of a local
11 department of social services; one shall be a physician's assistant, nurse
12 practitioner, or physician who is not a psychiatrist; one shall be a psychiatrist; one
13 shall be a representative of a local commission on aging; one shall be a professional
14 representative of a local nonprofit social service organization; one shall be a lawyer;
15 two shall be lay individuals; one shall be a registered nurse; one shall be a
16 professional in the field of disabilities; and one shall be a person with a physical
17 disability; and

19 WHEREAS, § 14-402(b) of the Family Law Article of the State Code provides that
20 the term of a member is three years, that, at the end of a term, a member continues
21 to serve until a successor is appointed and qualifies, and that a member who is
22 appointed after a term has begun serves only for the rest of the term and until a
23 successor is appointed and qualifies; and

25 WHEREAS, the term of a lay member expired on July 30, 2018; and

27 WHEREAS, the County Executive, subject to the advice and consent of the County
28 Council, has appointed NaToya Mitchell, a lay individual, to serve on the Anne
29 Arundel County Adult Public Guardianship Review Board for a term expiring on
30 July 30, 2021; and

32 WHEREAS, the County Council, after public hearing, finds that NaToya Mitchell
33 meets the eligibility requirements under § 14-402 of the Family Law Article of the
34 State Code and is qualified to serve on the Anne Arundel County Adult Public
35 Guardianship Review Board; now, therefore, be it

37 *Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it hereby*
38 *approves the appointment of NaToya Mitchell, a lay individual, to serve as a member of*

1 the Anne Arundel County Adult Public Guardianship Review Board for a term expiring on
2 July 30, 2021; and be it further

4 *Resolved*, That a copy of this Resolution be sent to County Executive Steuart Pittman;
5 appointee NaToya Mitchell; and Kaley Schultze, Boards and Commissions Coordinator
6 and Legislative Assistant.
