WHEREAS, § 3-2A-04 of the Education Article of State Code requires the County Council to select a qualified individual to fill any vacancy in the office of an elected member of the Board for the remainder of the term and until a successor is elected and qualifies; and

WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 40-21 the County Council determined a process for filling the vacancy in the office of the elected member from District 1 on the Board of Education for Anne Arundel County; now, therefore, be it

Resolved by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That it hereby elects Gloria Dent to serve as the District 1 representative on the Board of Education for Anne Arundel County for the remainder of a term that ends on December 1, 2024 and until a successor is elected and qualifies; and be it further

Resolved, That the County Council hereby extends its warmest welcome and congratulations to the new District 1 representative on the Board of Education for Anne Arundel County; and be it further
