One Flashing Light at a Time

We've installed Crosswalk Beacons at select crossings throughout the County. Pedestrians and drivers alike benefit from this technology!

Pedestrians and Cyclists using the crosswalk, follow these 3 easy steps:

- 1 **PRESS THE BUTTON** to make the lights flash.
- 2 **WAIT** for an adequate gap in traffic to proceed — we cannot guarantee traffic will stop.
- 3 **STAY ALERT** as you cross the street.

Drivers and Cyclists approaching the crosswalk on the roadway, follow these 6 easy steps:

- 1 **ANTICIPATE** people crossing whenever you see a crosswalk and **SLOW** down.
- 2 **LOOK** for yellow flashing lights from the Crosswalk Beacon.
- 3 **STOP** for pedestrians and bicyclists in the crosswalk even if the flashing lights are not active.
- 4 **DO NOT PASS** other vehicles stopped at the crosswalk.
- 5 **STOP** your vehicle in front of the crosswalk. Do not stop on the crosswalk.
- 6 **WAIT** for pedestrians and bicyclists to clear the crosswalk before proceeding — even if the Crosswalk Beacon stopped flashing.
