



Robinson Road Pedestrian Crossing Signal Modification

January 2024

The Anne Arundel County Department of Public Works, Traffic Engineering Division, will be modifying the operation of the recently constructed traffic signal at the intersection of Robinson Road and the B&A Trail Crossing to improve safety and operations. We have observed the operation of the existing full-color traffic signal that was constructed earlier in 2023 and we have concerns with compliance to the signal by both drivers and trail users.

The modified signal will provide a rapid yellow flashing indication to the drivers traveling along Robinson Road when the pedestrian buttons are pushed or a trail user is detected at the trail crossing locations. The flashing indications will not require drivers to stop, but will warn them that a trail user is waiting to cross. Trail users are required to wait for an appropriate gap in traffic to cross the roadway. Please reference the brochure in this mailing for more detailed information on how the modified signal will operate.
