litter. A person may not dispose of solid waste that originates or is generated outside the County and may not dispose of off-the-road equipment tires or combustion ash. RECYCLABLE MATERIALS SHALL BE SEPARATED FROM TRASH OR OTHER WASTE BEFORE DISPOSAL, AND A PERSON MAY NOT DISPOSE OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WITH TRASH OR OTHER WASTE MATTER.

(H) **Sanctions for Violation.** A PERSON WHO DISPOSES OF RECYCLABLE MATERIALS WITH TRASH OR OTHER WASTE MATTER AT A COUNTY OWNED LANDFILL OR SOLID WASTE FACILITY IN VIOLATION OF SUBSECTION (C) IS GUILTY OF A MISDEMEANOR AND ON CONVICTION IS SUBJECT TO A FINE NOT EXCEEDING \$100.

SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted*, That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days from the date it becomes law.
