If approved in whole or in part after the 45 days, the approved 30 provisions of this Ordinance shall take effect on the date the notice of approval is received 31 by the Office of Planning and Zoning. If disapproved in whole or in part, the disapproved 32 portions of this Ordinance shall be null and void without the necessity of further action by 33 the County Council. The Office of Planning and Zoning, within five days after receiving 34 35 any notice from the Maryland Critical Area Commission, shall forward a copy to the Administrative Officer for the County Council. 36
