

River Days Boat Rides & Kayak Lessons

Saturday, September 14th at Fort Smallwood Park

In an effort to make the registration process easier and get more residents out on the water, boat rides and kayak lessons at the September 14th River Days Festival will be available first come, first served to attendees.

Boat Rides: We will have two of [Watermark's 21 passenger Miss Anne boats](#) providing 30 minute rides throughout the day. There will be a total of 10 boat rides, and 210 tickets. **Boat rides are very popular, so please arrive at the beginning of the festival if you would like to try to get a ticket.** In order to ensure all tickets are used, your whole party must be present to reserve tickets. Since tickets are limited, we kindly ask that if you have already enjoyed a boat ride at River Days this summer that you allow others to take advantage of this opportunity.

When you arrive at the festival, please visit the boat ride table near the dock to inquire about available times and pick up tickets for your group. Children of all ages are welcome accompanied by an adult and are considered a passenger.

Kayak Lessons: Discover the basics of kayaking with a 45-minute beginner's paddle lesson with the Department of Recreation & Parks. There will be four lessons throughout the day, with 10 tickets available for each time slot.

When you arrive at the festival, please visit the welcome tent near the front of the festival to inquire about available times and pick up tickets for your group. To participate in a lesson, you must be 9 years of age or older, and complete a waiver at the festival.
