## A BILL ENTITLED

1 AN ORDINANCE concerning: Crimes, Civil Offenses, and Fines – Crimes –  
2 Miscellaneous Prohibited Act

3  
4 FOR the purpose of defining “recreational vehicle”; prohibiting the use of a recreational  
5 vehicle on a highway as a dwelling; allowing sanctions for a violation; and generally  
6 relating to crimes, civil offenses, and fines.

8 BY adding: § 9-1-713

11 SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland,*  
12 That Section(s) of the Anne Arundel County Code (2005, as amended) read as follows:

20 **9-1-713. Recreational vehicle on County roads for living purposes.**

22 (A) **Definitions.** IN THIS SECTION “RECREATIONAL VEHICLE” MEANS A CAMPING  
23 VEHICLE, MOTOR HOME, PARK MODEL RECREATIONAL VEHICLE, OR TRAVEL TRAILER, AS  
24 DEFINED BY THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE STATE CODE.

26 (B) **Prohibition.** A PERSON MAY NOT USE OR OCCUPY A RECREATIONAL VEHICLE  
27 PARKED ON A HIGHWAY, AS DEFINED BY THE TRANSPORTATION ARTICLE OF THE STATE

5 SECTION.

7 SECTION 2. *And be it further enacted,* That this Ordinance shall take effect 45 days  
8 from the date it becomes law.
