A public meeting has been scheduled for Wednesday, November 6, 2024 to discuss plans to reconstruct Jumpers Hole Road from MD 2 (Ritchie Highway) to MD 177 (Mountain Road) to improve traffic safety, mobility and accessibility for all road users. Pedestrian and bicycle facilities (sidewalks, paths, crosswalks) would be constructed along the entire corridor, along with curb-and-gutter and median islands to manage motorist travel speeds. A new traffic signal at Evening Star Drive would be installed as well.
