AN ORDINANCE concerning: Current Expense Budget – Supplementary Appropriation - Severn Grove Special Community Benefit District 2 3 FOR the purpose of providing an appropriation of funds from unanticipated revenues for 4 the Severn Grove Special Community Benefit District for the current fiscal year; and 5 generally relating to making supplementary appropriations of funds to the current 6 expense budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025. BY amending: Current Expense Budget 10 WHEREAS, under Section 712 of the Charter, upon the recommendation of the County Executive, the County Council may make supplementary appropriations 12 from revenues received from anticipated sources but in excess of budget estimates 13 and from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget for the 14 current fiscal year, provided that the Controller shall first certify in writing that such 15 funds are available for appropriation; and 16 18 WHEREAS, the County Executive has recommended a supplementary

appropriation of community held fund balance for the Severn Grove Special Community Benefit District in the amount of \$24,011.33, and the Controller has certified in writing that such funds are available for appropriation; now, therefore,

SECTION 1. Be it enacted by the County Council of Anne Arundel County, Maryland, That the Current Expense Budget for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2025, is hereby amended by making supplementary appropriations from revenues received from sources not anticipated in the budget to the Severn Grove Special Community Benefit District in the amount of \$24,011.33.
