> RE: Bill 90-24: An Ordinance Concerning: Capital Budget and Program - Roads and Bridges, Traffic Control, Board of Education, and Recreation and Parks capital projects –Supplementary and Transfer of Appropriations

Dear County Executive Pittman:

The Planning Advisory Board (PAB) is a citizen advisory board created by §532 of the Anne Arundel County Charter. Under § 533 of the Charter, the PAB is charged with recommending the list of capital projects, along with their estimated costs, to be implemented by the County. Also under § 533, the PAB considers and transmits advisory recommendations for amendments to the Capital Budget to the County Executive through the course of the year.

The PAB met on October 23, 2024 and received an overview of Bill 90-24 from the Office of Budget. This Ordinance is for the purpose of amending the Capital Budget for Fiscal Year 2025 by providing supplementary appropriations and/or transfer of appropriations for the following Capital Improvement Projects:

- Bluewater / Milestone Shared Use Path (SUP) (H587300): Transfer of appropriations after receiving \$849,600 in State grants and an equal de-appropriation of General County Bonds.
- New Traffic Signals (H479400): Supplemental appropriations after receiving \$252,000 in a State grant.
- Streetlight Conversion (H550700): Supplemental appropriations after receiving \$1,060,800 in a State grant.
- Security Related Upgrades (E538100): Supplemental appropriations after receiving \$791,646 in a State grant.
- Building Systems Renovation (E538200): Supplemental appropriations after receiving \$7,110,514 in a State grant.
- School Bus Replacement (E538800): Supplemental appropriations after receiving \$1,650,000 in State grants.

- Old Mill Middle School North (E550300): Supplemental appropriations after receiving \$2,010,154 in a State grant.
- Sustainability Initiatives (E591700): Supplemental appropriations after receiving \$2,722,349 in a State grant and \$1,852,968 as a Federal tax credit.
- WB & A Trail (P393600): Transfer of appropriations after receiving approximately \$560,000 in a State grant and an equal de-appropriation of General County Bonds.

Following the presentation and discussion of each project class in Bill 90-24, the PAB voted 5-0 to offer an advisory recommendation of approval of Bill 90-24.
