



### Passio GO!

The **Passio GO!** app allows riders to see bus locations in real-time, along with passenger capacity and estimated time of arrival. The app is free to download on all Android and iOS devices.

### Transit (App)

Similar to Passio, the **Transit** app allows riders to view real-time bus locations and ETAs. However, it also integrates with other transit systems, including Light Rail, MARC, WMATA, and MTA, making it ideal for riders who transfer between systems. The app is free to download on Android and iOS devices.

## How to Read this Schedule:

- 1 First, find the schedule for the day of the week you wish to travel: **INSERT DAYS OF OPERATION**
- 2 Next, find the **TIMEPOINT** closest to your origin and destination. The schedule lists timepoints only; additional stops are available and are not shown in the schedule. **BOLD NUMERALS** indicate PM times.
- 3 Finally, Look below your timepoint to see when buses depart from that location. Arrive at your bus stop 5-10 minutes early so that we don't miss you!

**TIP!** With the **Passio GO!** app, you can track the location of your bus in real-time and see the ETA for every stop on the route. No need to worry about missing your bus. Set alerts and more!

We strongly recommend calling at least two hours in advance to ensure service availability. Teens (13+) require signed permission from a guardian to ride alone. Children 12 and under must ride with an adult.
