Summary of Legislation

This resolution approves the application to the United States Department of Justice (DOJ), Office of Justice Programs for a grant under the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) Program federal fiscal year 2024 (FY24) Local Solicitation in the amount of \$141,404 and recognizes that the County Executive, or their designee, is duly authorized to act in connection with the grant. Applications for this program were due by December 6, 2024; however, the Administration did not indicate if an extension had been provided to allow for a late submission.

Review of Fiscal Impact

This resolution approves the application for this grant in the amount of \$141,404 for the federal FY24 grant to be received in the County's fiscal year 2025 (FY25). Funding for the State's Attorney Office (SAO); Partnership for Children, Youth and Families (PCYF); Department of Health; and Circuit Court's portion of this grant was included in the County's FY25 Approved Budget; however, the Office of the Sheriff's portion of this funding was not included in the County's FY25 Approved Budget and a supplementary appropriation will be required to spend these funds in FY25 if the grant is awarded. This grant does not require any County matching funds.
