



## Anne Arundel County Police Department End of Year Crime Data

The data displayed on this report is derived from police reporting in the Anne Arundel County Police's Records Management System (RMS) and is subject to change.

The data complies with the standards set by the FBI's National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) and reflects the most current information available at the time of publication. The National Incident-Based Reporting System, or NIBRS, was implemented to improve the overall quality of crime data collected by law enforcement. It captures details on each single crime incident—as well as on separate offenses within the same incident. A unique Offense ID is created for each individual offense reported to the police and is stored in the department's RMS.

The data displayed in this report is being counted by the Offense ID for most categories. However, certain categories such as shooting events and victim categories are counted at the incident or persons level respectively. A single Offense ID may contain multiple victims, which is not reflected in this data unless specified.

There are two categories of offenses reported in the NIBRS: Group A and Group B. Group A offenses are used to report all incidents committed within a law enforcement agency's jurisdiction to the NIBRS, whereas Group B offenses are used only to report arrest data. Some data displayed may contain both NIBRS groups unless specified.

Crime data is dynamic and may be updated or modified due to factors such as expungements, corrections, reclassifications, or the inclusion of new information. While every effort is made to ensure accuracy, users should be aware of the fluid nature of this data and exercise caution when interpreting or utilizing statistics.

### Key Terms

**Offense ID** - Distinct identifier to denote when there are multiple offenses associated with a single report.

\* Indicates partial or incomplete reporting of a specific offense or category.

**TFA/Parts** - Theft from an automobile to include any car/truck parts such as wheels, catalytic converters, etc.

A **Contact Shooting Event** is an incident where the unlawful shooting of a firearm occurs and a victim was struck by gunfire but any injuries sustained were not fatal. There can be multiple victims in a single **Contact Shooting Event** and this number is the total amount of Contact Shooting Events where the Anne Arundel County Police is the primary investigating agency. This total excludes any contact shooting victim(s) within a Homicide Shooting Event.

A **Non-Contact Shooting Event** is any unlawful shooting of a firearm where the projectile(s) did not strike a person. This does not include calls for "shots heard" where there is no evidence or witnesses to confirm a shooting took place.

**Ghost Guns** are unserialized (and therefore untraceable) firearms that are put together by components purchased either as a kit or as separate pieces.

**ERPO/Protective Order**: This category represents firearms collected during the service of an Extreme Risk Protection Order or a Protective Order issued by the courts.
