Subject: Bill No. 18-25 – AN ORDINANCE concerning: Boards, Commissions,

and Similar Bodies – Zoning – Mixed Use Districts

This summary was prepared by the Anne Arundel County Government Relations Office for use by members of the Anne Arundel County Council during consideration of Bill No. 18-25.

Summary

This ordinance amends Article 3 and Article 18 as they relate to the rezoning of Mixed-Use properties, in light of Bill 75-24, which revised the County Code provisions pertaining to Mixed-Use Districts. This ordinance requires that any lot designated as a mixed-use planned land use in a region plan adopted between May 6, 2024 and December 31, 2024 (i.e. Region Plans 2, 4, and 7) may not be administratively rezoned to mixed-use unless a sector study or plan for that lot has been completed and recommends a rezoning to a mixed-use district. It also requires that if a region plan adopted between January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2026 recommends a sector plan or study for a lot designated as a mixed use planned land use, the lot may not be administratively rezoned to a mixed use district unless the sector plan or study is completed and recommends a rezoning to a mixed use district.

Purpose

This ordinance requires that a sector plan or study be completed prior to the administrative rezoning of a lot that was identified as a mixed-use planned land use in a region plan adopted between May 6, 2024 and December 31, 2024 and that such plan or study recommend a rezoning to a mixed-use district. It also requires that if a region plan adopted between January 1, 2025, and December 31, 2026 recommends a sector study or plan for lot with a mixed-use planned land use, that study or plan and a corresponding recommendation be complete prior to an administrative rezoning.

Note: This Legislative and Fiscal Summary provides a synopsis of the legislation as introduced. It does not address subsequent amendments to the legislation.
